

## POLZEATH SURF LIFESAVING CLUB CLUB CRAFT USE June 2023

- 1. Senior & Master's that have full membership are welcome to take out training surf craft (rescue / racing boards) when they have achieved their SLSGB Level 2 award for competence in the appropriate craft.
- 2. The craft awards depend on the successful completion of a Level 2 Surf Swim award (speak with your coordinator regarding this). This award needs to be renewed every 2 years.
- 3. Please, only take out the designated training craft available. This must be signed in / out using the Club Craft Form. Failing to do so will stop the member having this privilege.
- 4. It is important that equipment is maintained for all to enjoy. If any craft is damaged, please report this by using the Craft Use Form and email it to <a href="mailto:craft@polzeathslsc.co.uk">craft@polzeathslsc.co.uk</a> with details.
- 5. Junior club members aged 14 and over by 31<sup>st</sup> of August who hold the Level 2 Board Competency award may take out designated training boards, if an adult club member who holds the lifeguard qualification has agreed (e.g., conditions are suitable etc.). This adult member's name must be recorded on the form.
- 6. Nipper members who hold the Nipper Silver Award can use designated Nipper training boards when with a Level 2 coach in the water, signing the boards in/out with Level 2 coaches name recorded.
- 7. To gain access of the Club to use club craft you will need to get in contact with your coordinator once they are satisfied you have the competence, they will give you the code.
- 8. Any misuse of the Club or equipment and not abiding by these rules this privilege will be taken away.
