- 8. To compete by the rules never argue with a Coach, Referee or other Official.
- 9. To co-operate with your Coach, the Referees, and team-mates.
- 10. To be punctual and dressed in the appropriate kit.
- 11. To be a positive role model for SLSGB, Polzeath Surf Lifesaving Club and be a team player.
- 12. To play for your own enjoyment and to improve your skills.
- 13. To attend at least 1 in 4 training sessions if not your Coach will discuss your absence.
- 14. Not misuse their authority or office for personal or other gain
- 15. Have a duty to provide information if requested by the Disciplinary Committee investigating any breach of this code.
- 16. Fully uphold the good practice and conduct requirements set out in the SLSGB Safeguarding Guidance adopted by the Club.

## **CODE OF CONDUCT FOR PARENTS AND SUPPORTERS**

- 1. To agree to abide by the Club rules and Code of Conduct.

- 4. To focus on their child's efforts and performance rather than winning and losing never to ridicule or yell at their child or other children for making a mistake or for other situations that might arise

- 6. To respect Officials' decisions and teach their children to do likewise.
- 7. To lead by example and respect all participants, Coaches, Referees, and spectators physical or verbal abuse will not be tolerated
- 8. To recognise and respect all volunteers who are giving up their valuable time.
- 9. To raise any personal concerns with Club Officials in private.
- 10. To refrain from making remarks based on race, religion, gender or ability.
