

POLZEATH SURF LIFESAVING CLUB SKI POLICY October 2022

- 1. A risk assessment must be completed by a Level 2 Coach.
- 2. A register of members taking part must be completed in and out of the water.
- 3. The ski must be checked over before going into the water for issues or damage.
- 4. The Lead Coach must give a safety briefing before entering the water.
- 5. When paddling outside of the bay, all ski paddlers are to wear a buoyancy aid (personal flotation device) with a whistle.
- 6. The Lead Coach can make a judgement call on PFD's when conditions suit i.e flat water.
- 7. When paddling in the Estuary from Wadebridge, Rock and Porthilly, all ski paddlers are to wear a buoyancy aid (personal flotation device) with a whistle.
- 8. Members are to dress for the weather, wear appropriate paddling / wetsuit gear for the conditions.
- 9. The Lead Coach is to take either a mobile phone or VHF radio in a waterproof pouch.
